TRAVEL VACCINES

Don't forget to contact the Surgery in plenty of time (six weeks preferably) if you are planning to travel abroad. We can advise on an immunisation schedule for you, depending on your destination and can also offer you general travel advice such as hygiene and use of sunscreens. You can email us your details and we will respond to your enquiry within 48 hours.

Please note that you no longer need a prescription for malaria medication- all local chemists can now provide this over the counter.

Whether you are staying at home or going abroad please be aware of the damaging effects of the sun. People most at risk are fair skinned, have freckles or ginger hair. For some people excessive exposure can cause skin cancer.

What can be prescribed by your GP is changing

Please do not be offended if your GP can no longer prescribe medicines for minor ailments such as head lice, mild acne, mild cystitis, vitamins and hay fever.

All GPs in England have been asked to stop issuing prescriptions for some conditions that can be treated with medicines that can be purchased at your local pharmacy. Your GP will diagnose your condition and give you advice on what to try or purchase. Alternatively, your local community pharmacist will be able to help you manage the condition. A leaflet is available in the practice which lists which conditions this applies to and answers commonly asked questions.

Stronger, prescription-only medicines are NOT affected by this change.

EPS has been an amazing addition to our Surgery. All you need to do is let us know which Pharmacy you wish to collect your medication from. You can still request your medication in the same way, ECONSULT, email, NHS App or even a request slip in our letter box on the outside wall! Your prescription is then sent directly to the Pharmacy for you to collect.


