Wednesday 22nd May - Regular appointment slots and times will be available for all patients

APPOINTMENTS

The Surgery offers a range of appointments. These can be with the GP, face to face or a telephone appointment. As we work as part of the Primary Care Networks, (PCN) offering additional services, you can also book appointments at St Marks Hospital for; Doctors/Nurses/Physiotherapists/Mental Health Advisors, plus evenings and weekends.

The reception staff can offer you an appointment at the Surgery if available at the time.

If you attend the Surgery for an appointment:-

- 1 Please attend on time if you are late, we may have to reschedule your appointment
- 2 We no longer require patients to wear facemasks. However, facemasks are available at the Surgery should you wish to wear one, or ask the clinician to wear a mask.

Your local pharmacy can now see you and prescribe for seven conditions.


